

The Ormsby City Council met Monday, July 2, 2012. Present at the meeting were Mayor Nick Hager, Council Members Dave Pettis, Glen Hartke, Chuck Nibbe and Charlie Waterbury.

Minutes and financial reports were approved on a motion by Nibbe, seconded by Pettis. Bills presented for payment were approved on a motion by Waterbury, seconded by Hartke.

DELING RESIDENCE UPDATE – Everett us going to dig up the”Y” that didn’t get shut off near their driveway. There is a 3 foot apron of cement that will probably be damaged by the digging.

WASTEWATER - The law suit with Kirschman’s has been resolved. On a motion by Pettis, seconded by Nibbe and approved by the council, the city will sign the agreement to pay \$6000.00 (which will be grant money from Rural Development) to Kirschman. Then we will receive the final bill from Kirschman’s for \$19,000.00 which will be the city’s responsibility.

Bakken’s are spraying weeks at the pond site. The dirt pile in town can be used by any resident in town and the dirt by the pond can be used by anyone.

CITY HALL ROOF UPDATE – There will be another bid coming in soon other than the Laraway bid. The council will hear both bids and discuss it further at the next meeting. Charlie Waterbury will try to fix the plumbing problem in the hall some night after work and will donate his labor.

ORMSBY NIGHT OUT – This will be held Tuesday, August 7th at 6:00 p.m. at the ball field.

SPECIAL ELECTION – Due to the fact Glen Hartke will be moving to the country, his 2 years remaining on the council will be put up for anyone to file and it will be voted on with the election in November.

NUWAY CONTRACT – 3500 gallons of L.P. were contracted for \$1.17 on a motion by Hartke, seconded by Pettis.
