- **ORMSBY CITY COUNCIL POSITION:**
- It is with heavy hearts that the Ormsby City Council seeks interested residents to fill the position of Dusty Fedder on the Ormsby City Council. The Council has approved to appoint the position until a special election can be held in the Fall of 2014. Interested residents need to be 21 years of age, a resident of the city, a US citizen, and does not have a felony record. The position will be appointed at the Ormsby City Council Meeting on May 6th, 2013 at 7 pm. Anyone interested in the position should contact a City Council Member and/or attend the meeting in May.

- **DISPOSAL OF TREES, BRANCHES, LEAVES:**
- Currently there is no place in the City of Ormsby to dispose of trees, branches, leaves, and compost materials. Burning of branches, wood, and leaves are allowed within the City limits if done in a 3x3x3 contained area and monitored at all times. **NO GARBAGE IS TO BE BURNED!**
The Meadowlark Compost Site is available for disposal of garden debris, grass clippings, tree branches, and unpainted wood material. The compost site is located in St. James and the hours are Wednesday from 4-7pm and Saturday from 8-12 & 1-5. The site is not open during inclement weather. There is a fee to use the Meadowlark site – Contractor Fee-\$100 per season, User Fee - \$1 per day, or Punch Card - \$10 for 12 times.
